
ABC Drills



These two examples of effective ABC drills create tight lines near guns and near old falls. Although the lines are quite tight, the fall areas are fairly distinct. With limited help you can have fewer throwers than the number of stations, but you should have each station well-identified with a chair and white coat, or some kind of stick figure. The longest stations are usually 125-175 yards long – much shorter than conventional field trial tests. ABC drills are always run as singles.
